Pre-K

In a structured setting, our Pre-K emphasizes academic readiness skills in language arts and mathematics, providing a solid foundation for the full academic kindergarten program. A very unique academic feature to the City of Knowledge Islamic School is the Intermediate Program that is offered to Pre-K students that are 4 years old. This program introduces the 4 year old students to the Kindergarten academics of Saxon Phonics and Everyday Math. This is a transitional program taught by the Kindergarten teacher that further encourages the learning process for the future Kindergartners.

Kindergarten through Second Grades

The elementary students in Kindergarten, First, and Second grades continue in their rigorous academic studies in Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Health, Arabic, Islamic Studies and Art. Saxon Phonics is continued through the First grade curriculum and Everyday Mathematics is continued through Second grade.
